Foundations For Living offers Neurofeedback Treatment. Neurofeedback is a brain exercise that addresses problems of brain dysregulations, such as Anxiety, Depression, behavior disorders, sleep disorders, headaches, emotional disturbances, and many others.

We observe the brain in action from moment to moment and reward the brain for changing its own activity to more appropriate patterns.

Neurofeedback is like a personal training session for the brain. Training the brain to function at its maximum potential is similar to the way the body is exercised, toned, and maintained. Brain training exercises for the neural pathways allow the brain to have better function in a variety of areas.

- Suicidal behavior
- Disruptive behaviors

- ADHD
- PTSD
- Anxiety

OUR FACILITY AT A GLANCE

- 84 bed Residential Treatment Facility
- Treatment for males and females ages 11- 17 with an IQ of 55 and above
- Licensed by ODMH and CARF accredited
- All program services are Title IV-E eligible
- Three Distinct Programs:
PASSAGES - A concentrated mental health program with a strong emphasis on behavior modification for females
EXPEDITION - An intense mental health and behavior modification program for males
VISIONS - A dual disorders (substance dependence and mental health diagnoses) treatment program for females

SHORT-TERM ASSESSMENT PROGRAM

Our Short-Term Assessment program is 45 days in which the youth fully participates in the therapeutic milieu including Individual, Group, and Family Therapy.

Services include: Psychiatric Evaluation, Psychological Evaluation, Pharmacological Assessments, and a Medical Evaluation.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Foundations For Living provides an environment that treats the complex trauma associated with Human Trafficking. Treatment modalities used include: Cognitive-Behavioral Therapy, Trauma-Focused Cognitive-Behavioral Therapy, and EMDR. Many of these youth have drug and alcohol addiction, and therefore, we offer a dual diagnosis unit to treat both the emotional/mental health and chemical dependency issues.



TREATMENT DURING PREGNANCY

Foundations For Living provides treatment for pregnant youth struggling with mental health and/or substance-related disorders. Prior to birth, we will work with the youth’s home county to establish a plan for the newborn that may include adoption, foster care, or temporary placement with a relative. In conjunction with her regular mental health and/or substance-related disorders treatment, pregnant youth will also receive the following services:

- Pre-natal care
- Onsite nursing and comprehensive medical care
- Parenting classes
- Individual treatment focusing on pregnancy and parenting



SELF MUTILATION & INJURY

Our trained staff will assist youth by teaching how to identify self-harm triggers, teaching emotional regulation, and teaching safe coping strategies to express emotions.
